Deadline for abstract submission and conference registration is 1 July 2010

Abstract of proposed talks & posters should not exceed 200 words and may not contain any citations. Your abstract will form the basis of our decision as to whether or not your paper will be included. Your preference as to a poster or oral presentation will be taken into account as far as possible, depending on the availability of platform talks. Note that the abstract submitted will also constitute a submission for the symposium abstracts volume, which will be made available in PDF format from the SVPCA website.
